## Support for children entitled to Pupil Premium

The Government gives money to schools called ‘Pupil Premium’ to help children achieve their best. If a child qualifies for the Pupil Premium, they may be able to access funded places in clubs and activities. Your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium if you are entitled to certain benefits and/or you have a low income; your child is, or has been, ‘Looked After’ or if you are a Service Family.
